- Consider setting up a Charitable Gift Annuity and receive guaranteed payments for life - the remainder of your gift goes to our fund after you pass.

\$5,607 Awarded in 2019

The Hebron Area Community Foundation was created to be a resource to support local community initiatives which provide a higher quality of life in Hebron and the surrounding area.

This year, the Foundation's Advisory Committee awarded \$5,607.73 in seven grants to the following organizations:

- 4 grants to **Hebron Public School**:
 - \$1,000 for Activity/Sport Improvement Program
 - \$795 for Sensory Input Space
 - \$500 for Builders for a Brighter Future program
 - \$312.73 for "We're 'almost' Teenagers and We're Bored!" program
- \$1,000 to the **Hebron Fire Protection District** for fire fighting equipment
- \$1,000 to the **Hebron Senior Center** for their nutritional meal program
- \$1,000 to the **Hebron Public Library** for computers

Grants are awarded once a year. Any organization with a 501(c)(3) status or government agency may apply. Applications are available online beginning March 1, 2019 at www.NDCF.net/Hebron. ◇

4. Follow the instructions to complete the checkout process.

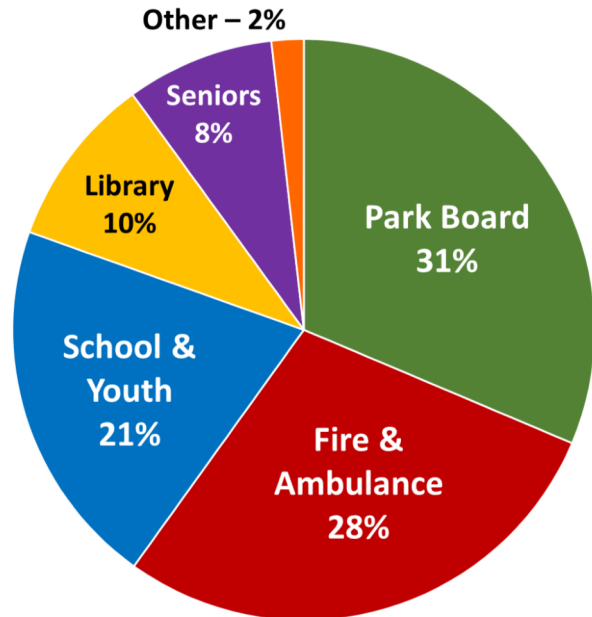
You will receive a tax receipt for your donation and you can change the amount or frequency of your gifts at any time.
