## Our Partnership

Our goal is to grow the fund to \$450,000 so we can award \$18,000 in grants yearly. Below are various ways that we can partner to achieve this goal.

- **Business Challenge Gifts:** Give to make a "challenge" to others in the community. Looking for 20 gifts which will strengthen our partnership & be used to engage commitment in the community.
- **Oil and Gas:** Help guide local or national dollars to non-endowment or endowment funds which improve health and safety services for your workers and their families. Find local resources to benefit the community at large, the workers employed and their families.
- **Agricultural:** Gifts of ag products, livestock, auctionable equipment, and real estate can be donated.
- **Financial Professionals:** Consider a gift on behalf of your firm. Donate back one "tax return cost" or money management income for the month. Also, help answer questions of generous people as to how best to use IRS and ND tax giving laws, ensure personal needs are met, and create a Living Legacy for their community.
- **Education:** Help get word out to alumni and parents about the importance of the fund. Set aside one "fundraiser" or funds from a project.
- **Service Groups:** Designate a fundraiser or some initiative once a year to help build fund.
- **Individual, Couples, and Families:** Those in and out of state, donate in honor of family members, or to establish a new family gift.

## How to Donate to the Fund

Donations to the **Parshall Area Community Foundation** are welcomed and accepted at any time of the year to ensure that the fund grows and continues to support our area in the future. There are many different ways to contribute:

### **Help Today.**

\*ND 40% income tax credit:

Anyone living in or out of the state receiving ND income may take advantage of the state's 40% tax credit. *(Restrictions apply—ask for details)*

### **Near Term: Giving for income**

Give a gift and get an income for your life or that of your spouse or family member. Remaining value becomes your gift to the fund. This is a great way to stabilize income—ask us how.

### **In the future: Your Legacy**

Set up a gift in your estate plans. Make a specific, percentage or residual designation in your will/trust or as a partial beneficiary of retirement fund or insurance and create a simple Legacy gift. This is a great way for you and/or your family to be remembered forever, to show your love for your community, and ensure services for the next generation.
