NDCF AWARDS \$207,850 IN GRANTS

Bismarck, North Dakota . . . The North Dakota Community Foundation has awarded \$207,850 in grants from its Statewide Greatest Needs (Unrestricted) Fund to 56 organizations across the state working to improve the quality of life for state residents.

“Our philosophy has always been to let the people in North Dakota tell us what they need, we don’t tell them what WE think they need,” said Kevin J. Dvorak, President & CEO of NDCF. “These grant awards represent a wide variety of projects and programs across our state that improve the quality of life for area residents and we are happy to help fund them.”

The NDCF Board of Directors reviewed and discussed 87 grant applications at their meeting in September to make the determination of awards. Grant awards are listed below by general area of the state. If the location is not obvious in the organization name, it has been added.
