The fund is invested in North Dakota with North Dakota companies like Bravera (American Trust), and the annual revenue is spun off to help fund important community programs and programs. Committee Awards \$7,120

The Glen Ullin Community Foundation Advisory Committee awarded \$7,120 in six different grants in April to the following organizations:

- **Crossroads Golf Association** for chemicals: \$1,440
- **GUPPIES** for flower boxes for the elderly: \$1,440
- **Marian Manor Healthcare Center** for the purchase of a floor scrubber: \$1,440
- **Glen Ullin Senior Citizens Club** to fix a leaking roof, add ceiling vents, replace insulation, and replace ceiling tiles: \$1,000
- **City of Glen Ullin** for a 2023 municipal building facelift: \$1,000
- **Glen Ullin Park Board** for a 2023 landscaping project: \$800

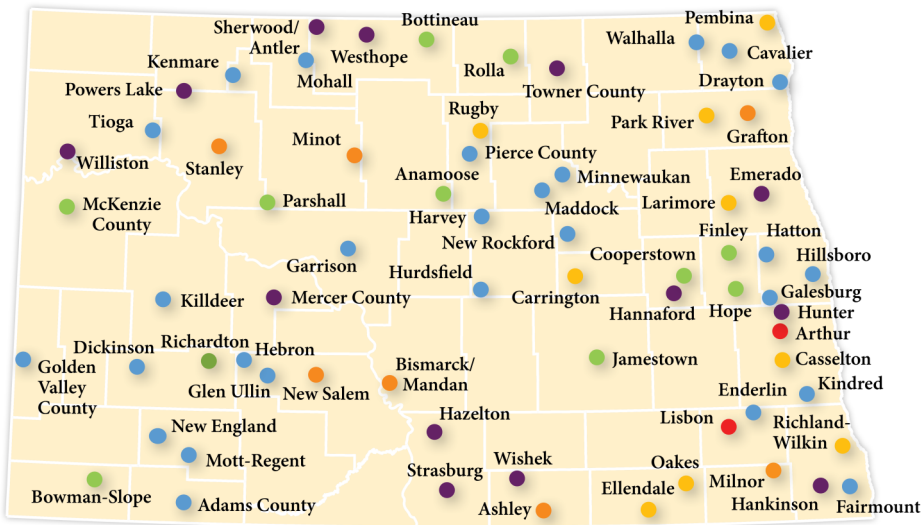
