Mission Statement

The mission of the North Dakota Community Foundation is to improve the quality of life for North Dakota’s citizens through charitable giving and promoting philanthropy.

About the North Dakota Community Foundation

The North Dakota Community Foundation was incorporated in 1976. NDCF is an IRS designated 501(c)(3) statewide, public, nonprofit, tax-exempt, corporation that receives and distributes charitable funds to support a wide range of programs that benefit North Dakotans.

NDCF was formed by a group of concerned citizens who were looking for a general charitable vehicle to build endowment to support the nonprofit sector in the state. Initial support for the Foundation came from the Otto Bremer Foundation (now the Otto Bremer Trust), the Northwest Area Foundation, the Norwest Bancorporation, the North Dakota Bremer Banks and the Bush Foundation.

NDCF has continued to grow and flourish over the years thanks to the support of thousands of individuals and businesses who want to make North Dakota a better place to live, work, and play.

National Standards

The National Standards Seal represents official confirmation from the Community Foundations National Standards Board that NDCF has met the most rigorous standards for community foundations. The seal affirms NDCF’s commitment to financial security, transparency, and accountability and says that our grantmaking includes an open, competitive process designed to address the changing needs of our community.

Chair & President's Letter

Connections—

Every year, the North Dakota Community Foundation makes connections with many different types of people. The one thing that nearly all have in common is their love of North Dakota and its citizens and a desire to make North Dakota a better place.

Sometimes we connect donors with a charity whose work touches their heart. Often we connect volunteers who want to get involved in their community with one of our 65 local community foundation advisory committees. We connect students to resources that can help them with their educational expenses. Financial advisors get connected to NDCF so that they can help their clients achieve their charitable goals and dreams. These are just some ways that the network that is NDCF builds connections, community and pride in North Dakota.

In 2018, we took our connecting to a new level and place. The North Dakota Picnic in Arizona had been held annually for over 50 years. It began with a group of "snowbirds" who gathered in Mesa at a local park to connect and re-connect with friends and former neighbors. As the years went by, the Picnic grew and needed an organizing entity to sign contracts with the City of Mesa and manage the event.

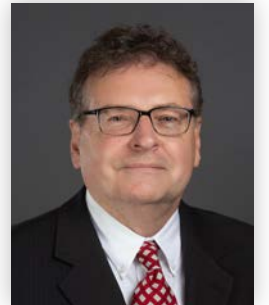
For many years, the Village Family Service Center, along with many local volunteers led by Darlene and Mike Wolf did that heavy lifting. The Picnic continued to grow and eventually the work became more than the Village desired to take on. In August of 2017, the Village asked if NDCF would like to take over the role of organizing the Picnic.

The Picnic aligned with our role in North Dakota of connecting people to their community and to great charitable work. We took on the task with a bit of trepidation as this was outside our comfort zone. Darlene and Mike and the dozens of volunteers helped us make the Picnic a great success. We had over 2,000 people attend the Picnic and enjoy a sunny, warm Sunday at Red Mountain Park in Mesa on March 4, 2018. It was a wonderful gathering and a lot of fun to see old friends discover each other in the crowd – check out the photos on page 7. We recently returned from the 2019 event, which drew the same size crowd and was even more fun!

We plan to continue this over 50-year tradition and use it to connect North Dakotans and former North Dakotans to each other and to celebrate their love for our state. 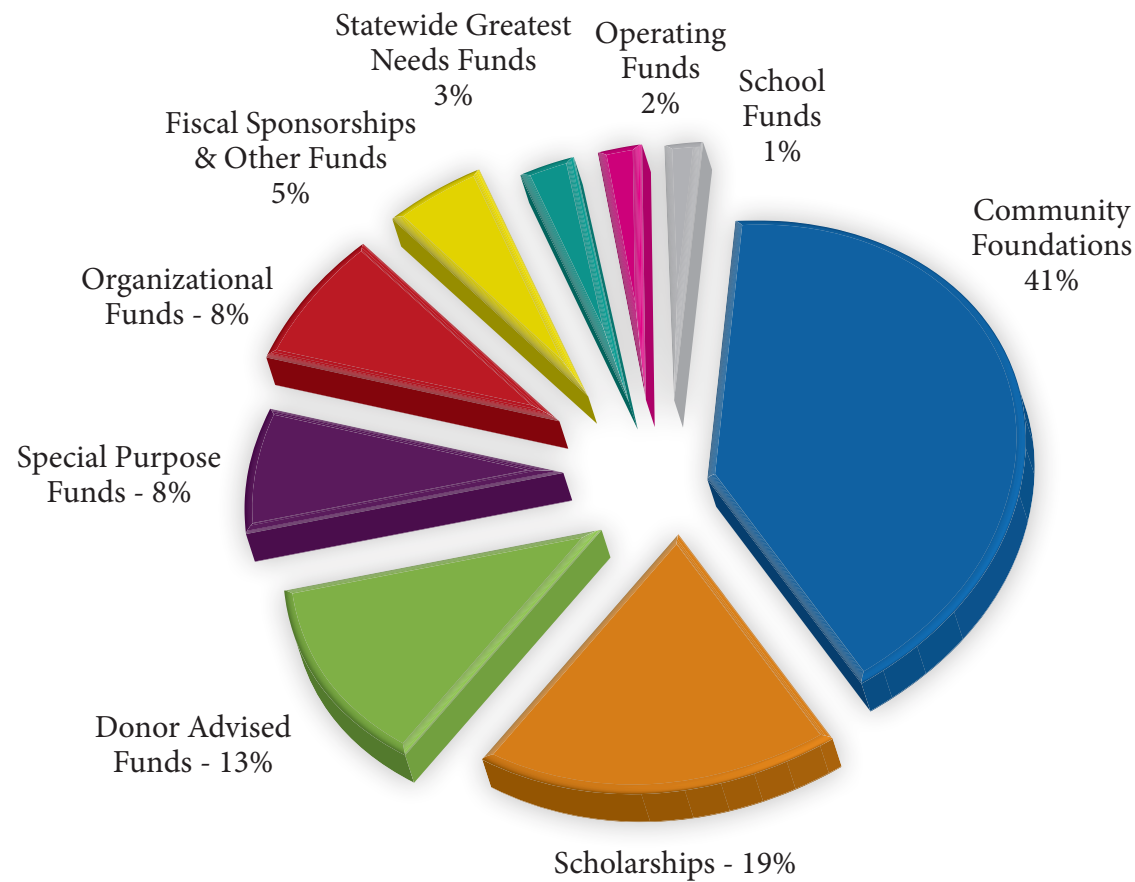

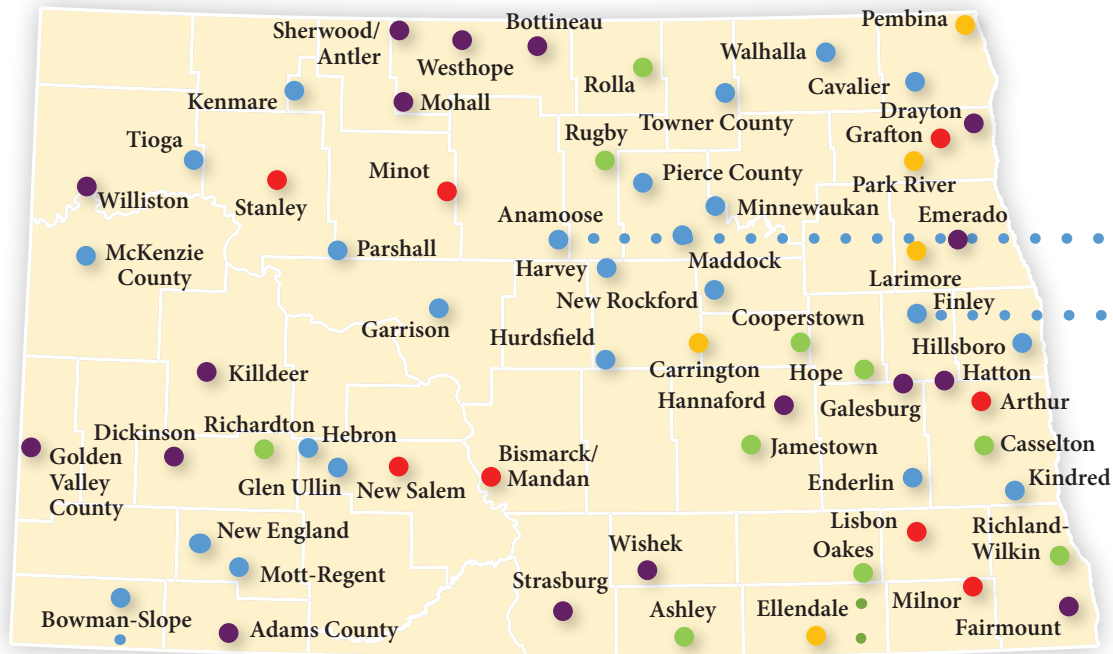


Our Community Endowment Funds

The Community Endowment Fund program is the signature program of the North Dakota Community Foundation. NDCF currently manages permanent endowment funds for 65 different communities or areas in the state. These funds each have an advisory committee made up of local residents that lead fundraising efforts and recommend grant awards. These grants fund projects and programs that greatly improve the quality of life in these communities. Here are some examples from 2018:



Everyone had a blast at the Dueling Pianos show in June, hosted by the Sherwood Antler Community Foundation! Community Foundations not only raise money for important community needs, they also bring fun events to their area.



The Bowman and Slope County Community Foundation held a Jail & Bail event in June to raise money for their fund. The sheriff's department had lots of fun bringing in the "perpetrators" and almost \$5,000 was raised for their area's permanent fund.



The Anamoose Area Community Foundation celebrated its 10th anniversary in 2018 with a community brunch. The fund has grown to over \$200,000 in total assets in that time and now awards over \$8,000 in grants every year! Finley Days is a wonderful community event with four days of activities, including a golf tournament, water carnival, bouncy houses, a parade, and street dance. The Finley Community Endowment Fund has provided grants for many years to help make this gathering possible.

The Oakes Area Community Foundation awarded over \$13,000 in grants in 2018! Grantees included the Oakes Boy Scouts for materials for their Eagle Scout projects, the Guelph Community Development Association to refinish their gym floor, and the Oakes Community Hospital Foundation for their patient room upgrades.



Statewide Greatest Needs Fund

NDCF's Statewide Greatest Needs Fund provides grant dollars for projects and programs across the state that make a significant difference in the quality of life of area residents. For some communities, NDCF's Statewide Greatest Needs Fund is the only funding source they have to help them make improvements in their town.

NDCF's Board of Directors reviews grant applications once a year and determines grant awards. NDCF was pleased to award \$149,174 in 2018 to 36 organizations, including those shown here.

NDCF awarded Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch a \$5,000 grant to provide Mental Health First Aid Training to their staff. The funds were used to send one Ranch staff person to a 5-day course that teaches skills needed to identify, understand, and respond to signs of mental health and substance abuse challenges and crises in others. The staff person received an instructor's certification to teach the course content to other Ranch staff, with the goal of training all new and current staff members (approximately 385 people) within a year. What a great way to maximize the impact of this grant and provide crucial support to North Dakota kids in need!

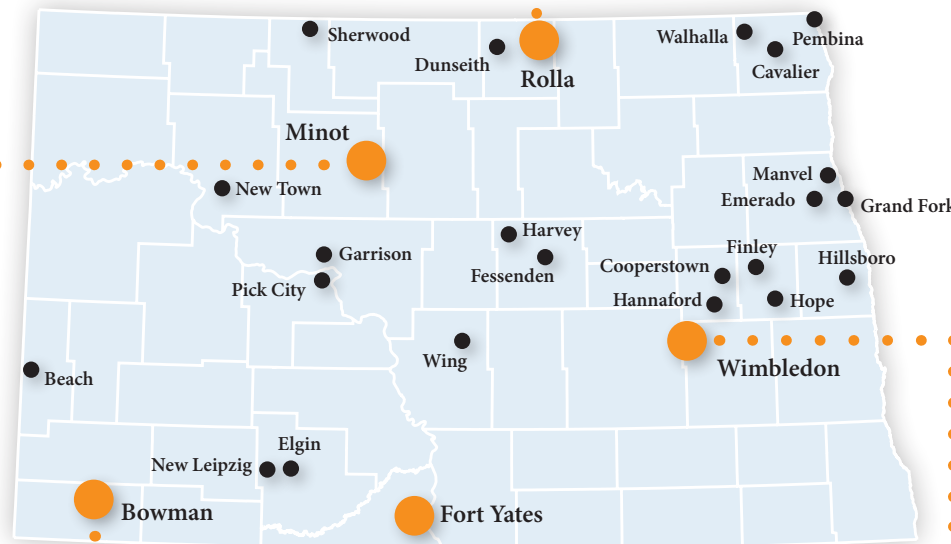
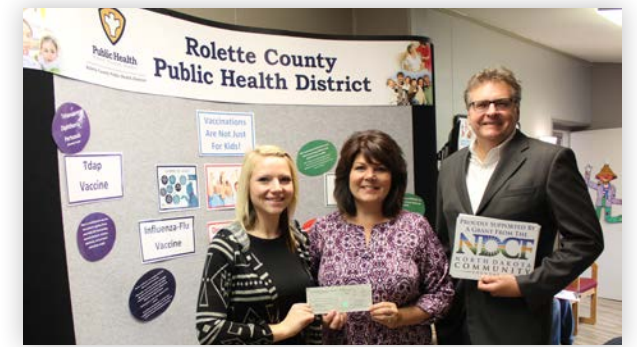


The Sunrise Foundation supports healthcare in southwestern North Dakota, including Bowman and Slope Counties. When the hospital and long-term care facility were combined into one building, the small Pioneer Park was demolished and there was no place for residents or patients to go outside. The \$5,000 grant from NDCF will be used to help develop an outdoor space with level sidewalks, grass and flowers, and patio furniture. "I have worked in long term care for twenty years and I know the benefits of residents being able to go outside," said Barbi Jo Narum, Sunrise Foundation Director. - The Rolette County Public Health District serves a population of over 14,000 people, providing preventative health screenings and other services. The \$2,500 grant they received from NDCF was used to purchase a Tympanogram Hearing Screening Tool, which will be used to conduct hearing screenings on more than 800 children a year. Identifying hearing loss or hearing related issues early can help minimize their impact on language, as well as educational, cognitive, and social development. - The Wimbledon Community Grocery is organized and operated exclusively for the purpose of providing a sustainable food system to an underserved population. It provides healthy food to about 750 rural residents in a 20-mile service area, including the communities of Courtenay, Dazey, Leal, and Spiritwood Lake. The \$5,000 grant from NDCF's Statewide Greatest Needs Fund will be used to replace the 50-year-old heating/cooling unit with a new heat pump and furnace, increasing the operating efficiency by 25-30%.

- Sitting Bull College in Ft. Yates received a \$5,000 grant to develop a Community Park within walking distance of the colleges' student housing for students and their families to use. The grant funds will be used to help purchase benches, swings, jungle type structures, slides, climbing areas and materials to install play equipment. Most of the colleges' students are first generation college students with at least one child. 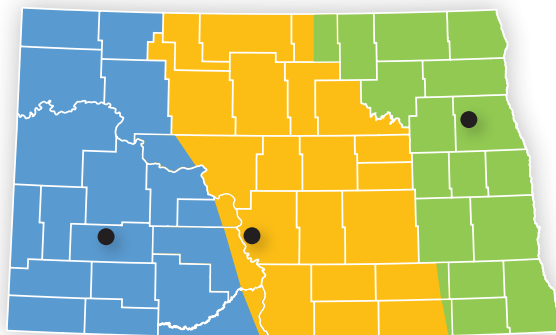

Supporting Our Schools: Giving Kids What They Need to Succeed

This interview with NDCF's President & CEO Kevin Dvorak was published online by the Rural Schools Collaborative in November of 2018 and talks about the importance of supporting our public schools.

Where is your hometown? Are you native to North Dakota?

I spent the first five years of my life in Vesleyville, ND. We moved 11 miles to Minto when I began kindergarten. My graduating class numbered 24 students, 16 boys and 8 girls. The opportunities that being in a small school afforded me were many. I participated in four sports at the varsity level, was in the class play, student government, boys state, the annual committee and probably more that I can't recall. What a rich experience it was for all of us.

What did you do before joining the North Dakota Community Foundation?

I was in sales with a major corporation traveling the western half of North Dakota. That experience taught me customer service, hard work and relating to a variety of people.

What are the biggest challenges to small towns in your state?

Every small town is unique with its own strengths and challenges. Some of the common issues are declining populations, low birth rates, lack of economic opportunities, declining local dining and entertainment opportunities as well as retail to include groceries and amenities.

In your mind, why are public schools so important to small towns?

A well-run public school can be a magnet for young families, not only keeping them in town, but drawing new residents as well. In my hometown, the school was the center of activity, especially when winter set in. The concerts, sporting events, programs and plays were well attended by not just the parents of the participants, but by other community members as well.

How does the North Dakota Community Foundation support public education and small rural schools?

We support local schools through our grantmaking from our Statewide Greatest Needs Fund and also from our 65 local community foundations, which are mostly in rural communities. These grants enhance the educational experience and the ability of schools to offer more for their students,

parents and the community at large. Some examples of actual projects and programs that these grants have funded include:

- Replacing outdated and unsafe playground equipment (Grenora, ND)
- Bringing a week-long theatre workshop to town so area schoolkids can experience acting and working together on a production, which is presented to the community at the end of the week (Cavalier, ND)
- Professional development books for educators to use in their group study (Lisbon, ND)
- New uniforms for their marching band (Stanley, ND)

We also help organize and manage school foundations, which are used to supplement tax dollars to provide above and beyond educational opportunities. These local school foundations keep capital in the community where it was earned so that the next generations can benefit from those dollars. By partnering with us, local schools don't have to run their foundation on their own, which can be time-consuming as there are some legal requirements that have to be met every year.

If you could wave a magic wand, what steps would you like rural school district communities to take to build a more sustainable future?

From the philanthropic perspective, the use of a local school foundation to capture financial resources is a big step toward sustainability. Those resources can not only reduce the burden on the tax base, but enhance the community and make your town a more desirable place to live. The local school foundation can be an important piece in the sustainability puzzle.

How can individuals work with the NDCF to make a difference in the future of their schools and communities?

Many of our school foundations were started with the impetus from a donor who wanted to help their alma mater. Their "lead gift" opened the door and inspired the creation of a school foundation to allow others to also help. We have worked with individuals who have come directly to us to provide gifts to support their local school, or to provide scholarship money for students, or to buy a grand piano for the music program. These are just some of the ways that the flexible tool that is a school foundation can be used to serve the needs of those who want to give and the needs of the school and its students.

By working with the North Dakota Community Foundation, the local school foundation has access to assistance from our marketing experts, our planned giving and fundraising experts as well as our state-of-the-art accounting and fund management. All of these assets allow you to approach donors in your community with the same sophisticated giving opportunities as any major charity, without having to have those people on your staff - they are included in the partnership with the North Dakota Community Foundation.
