\$2,700 Awarded in 2022

The SACF Advisory Committee awarded a total of \$2,700 in four different grants to the following organizations and projects in September:

- **BIO Girls:** \$300 for a BIO Girls program in Emmons County
- **Emmons County Ministerial Association:** \$500 for the Emmons County Food Pantry
- **Romanus F. Wagner Post No. 6264 Veterans of Foreign Wars:** \$1,000 for landscaping of VFW Park in Strasburg
- **Strasburg Nursing Home:** \$900 for Environmental Services Department Update

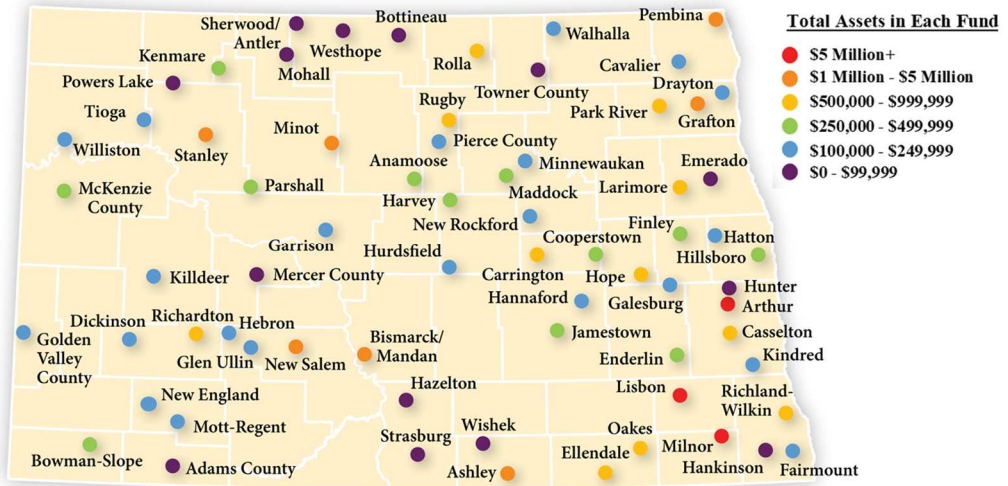

The program is in its 5th year in Emmons County and the 12-week season this fall culminated in the girls training for and successfully running a 5K (inside Linton Public School due to ice and snow on the streets). A grant from the foundation helped pay for supplies and materials.

There are over 69 local community foundations in North Dakota, some that started over three decades ago and others that started last year.

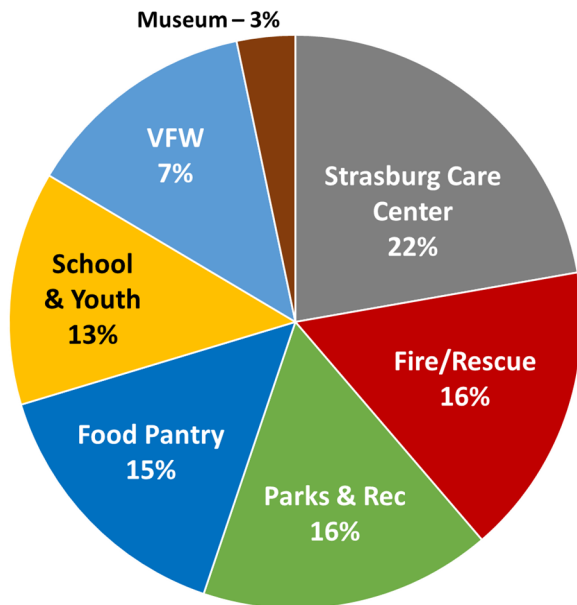
The larger these permanent endowment funds grow, the more earnings are available
