Enderlin Area Community Endow. Fund

- Established in 2014
- Market Value of Fund (as of 12/31/21): **\$272,906**
- Total Gifts to the Enderlin fund in 2021: **\$109,213**
- Total grants awarded in 2021 and 2022: **7 grants totaling \$11,141**
- Total grants awarded since inception: **24 grants totaling \$27,577**

Over \$11,000 Awarded in 2021 and 2022 Grants

2021

- **\$2,581 to SMP Health - Maryhill** for a bladder scanner
- **\$2,581 to the Nome Schoolhouse** for inside furnishings/window coverings.

2022

- **\$2,600 to the United Prairie Foundation/ Sheyenne Braves** for a new commercial oven for their community center
- **\$1,000 to the Enderlin Historical Society and Museum** for display expenses and flooring
- **\$889 to the Nome Schoolhouse** for an Animal Education Center
- **\$889 to the Enderlin Rural Fire Protection District** for the Sheldon Fire Hall/Community Center
- **\$600 to the Enderlin Municipal Library** for their After-School STEM Club

Grants are awarded once a year. Any organization with a 501(c)(3) status or government agency may apply.

Planned Giving Options

Along with our annual fundraisers (see photos at right), there are also opportunities to make other types of gifts, including planned gifts to the Enderlin Area Community Endowment Fund (EACEF) that may be of interest to our residents:

- **IRA Charitable Rollover** Individuals that are 70 1/2 or older may make gifts of up to \$100,000 directly from their IRA to the North Dakota Community Foundation, benefiting the EACEF. You can avoid taxes on the amount you transfer and satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD), if you are over 72.
- **Charitable Gift Annuity (CGA)** A Charitable Gift Annuity is a contract between a charity and an individual. The individual, referred to as the donor, transfers property to the NDCF for the EACEF and NDCF promises to pay a given amount at the end of each selected payment period to one annuitant for life or two annuitants for both lives (usually the donor or the donor and his/her spouse). The remaining principle is put in the EACEF when they pass.
- **Bequest** A bequest is property or money that you promise in your will to give to another person or organization after you die. If you would like to leave some or all of your estate to the EACEF, the bequest language is as follows:

"I give and bequeath to the North Dakota Community Foundation (Tax ID 45-0336015), a qualified charitable organization under IRS 501 (c)(3), located in Bismarck, North Dakota, _____ (a percentage of the estate, specific dollar amount, or remainder of estate) to the Enderlin Area Community Endowment Fund, a component fund of the North Dakota Community Foundation."
