NDCF AWARDS \$150,283 IN GRANTS

Bismarck, North Dakota . . . The North Dakota Community Foundation has awarded \$150,283 in grants from its Statewide Greatest Needs (Unrestricted) Fund to 36 organizations across the state working to improve the quality of life for state residents.

Established in 1976, the NDCF is a public, non-profit tax-exempt corporation which receives and distributes charitable funds to support a wide range of programs that benefit North Dakotans.
