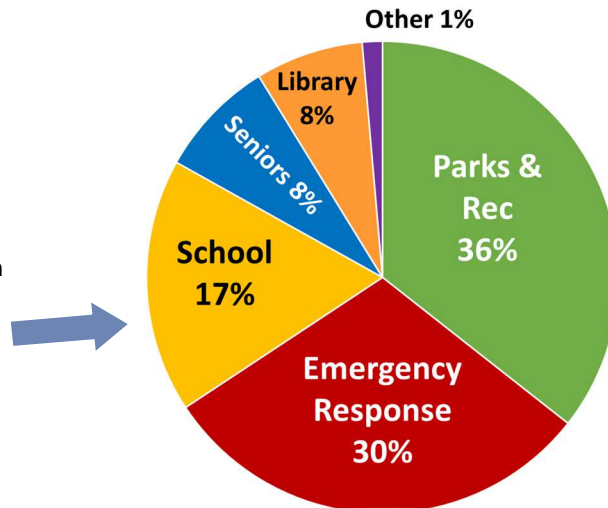
## Growing to Serve More

We encourage each family, individual, and business to make some sort of gift from time to time. Over the years, all those gifts will grow this permanent fund to be an even more valuable resource for our area.

We currently are considered a **Blue Dot Community** (assets between \$100,000 and \$250,000) but need to grow to a **Yellow Dot** (\$500,000 - \$1 M in assets) in order to meet the needs in our area.

The chart below shows other community funds and the impact they have in their area.

Fund	Asset Value	Approx. Annual Grants
Parshall	\$355,000	\$14,200
Richardton	\$555,000	\$22,200
New Salem	\$1.6 million	\$64,000
