About the North Dakota Community Foundation

The North Dakota Community Foundation was incorporated in 1976. NDCF is an IRS designated 501(c)(3) statewide, public, nonprofit, tax-exempt corporation that receives and distributes charitable funds to support a wide range of programs that benefit North Dakotans.

NDCF was formed by a group of concerned citizens who were looking for a general purpose charitable vehicle to build endowment to support important needs for communities and projects all across the state. Initial support for the Foundation came from the Otto Bremer Foundation (now the Otto Bremer Trust), the Northwest Area Foundation, the Norwest Bancorporation, the North Dakota Bremer Banks and the Bush Foundation.

NDCF has continued to grow and flourish over the years thanks to the support of thousands of individuals and businesses who want to make North Dakota a better place to live, work, and play.

National Standards

The National Standards Seal represents official confirmation from the Community Foundations National Standards Board that NDCF has met the most rigorous standards for community foundations. The seal affirms NDCF's commitment to financial security, transparency, and accountability and says that our grantmaking includes an open, competitive process designed to address the changing needs of our community.





NDCF was proud to participate in and sponsor the ND Association of Nonprofit Organization's Nonprofit Day at the Capitol in February. Kevin Dvorak and Christi Stonecipher staffed the booth, met with legislators, and shared the good work we do across the state. The nonprofit sector in North Dakota strengthens the economy as employers and improves communities through its work in arts and culture, education, the environment, health care, and human services.

Grid United partnered with us to help them distribute over \$697,000 in charitable dollars in the communities impacted by the construction of their North Plains Connector project, connecting the eastern and western power grids in the US. Our community foundation structure was a perfect vehicle to make sure their grants went to the projects and programs most important in these areas, as determined by our local advisory committees.



Our Community Foundations

Our local community foundations are the signature program of the North Dakota Community Foundation. NDCF currently manages local community funds for 69 different communities, counties, or areas in the state. These funds each have an advisory committee made up of local residents that lead fundraising efforts and recommend grant awards. These grants fund projects and programs that greatly improve the quality of life in these communities. It's an excellent example of local residents keeping their charitable dollars in their own hometown, supporting their own nonprofit organizations and needs. Here are some happenings from 2023:



- \$5 Million +
 - \$1,000,000 \$4,999,999 in total assets
- \$500,000 \$999,999 in total assets
- \$250,000 \$499,999 in total assets
- \$100,000 \$249,999 in total assets
- 0 \$99,999 in total assets

- Total assets in our Community Endowment Fund Program are over \$48 million!
- We received 1,762 donations to our community funds in 2023, totaling over \$2 million.
- 428 grants were awarded in 2023 from our Community Endowment Funds, totaling almost \$2.6 million!

HAZELTON



Statewide Greatest Needs Fund

NDCF's Statewide Greatest Needs Fund provides grant dollars for projects and programs across the state that make a significant difference in the quality of life of area residents. NDCF's Board of Directors reviews grant applications once a year and determines grant awards. NDCF was pleased to award \$207,850 in grants in 2023 to 56 organizations across the state, for statewide programs as well as projects in communities shown here.

West Fargo: Haley's Hope used their 2023 grant to develop, pilot, and evaluate a one-year plan for K-12 educators all across North Dakota. According to the ND Department of Public Instruction, more than 35,000 students in K-8 lack proficiency in reading. The National Center for Learning Disabilities has identified dyslexia as the primary cause of the issue. The program will help teachers and parents recognize and understand the way individuals with dyslexia learn.






Wolford: Father's Farm is a faith-based, non-profit organization, where men who are in recovery or recently released from incarceration learn practical skills and build character. "During the months of October and early November we had two new men getting established here at Fathers Farm who recently arrived in September. The first three months of a man's stay here is the most time intensive with mentoring. It's often the most rewarding as well. Jeremy and Tom have been doing fabulous here and during this grant period, they both improved in their addiction recovery to the point where they were able to take key employment jobs in the community - Jeremy working

in construction at a nearby hospital and Tom in housekeeping at a nearby hospital system - the hospital had been having trouble filling that position. Thus, the extended community was impacted in a positive way even in the second month of these two men being here."

Dickinson: Connect Medical Clinic received a grant for a location expansion project in order to respond to the demand for Connect's services. "Our patient appointments more than doubled in 2022 and are trending even higher in 2023. The project is important to teens, women, and men, especially those who are underinsured or uninsured. We charge minimal lab fees, so care is accessible and affordable. For those who cannot pay, we have a sponsorship fund we can provide them." NDCF's



grant helped furnish a patient exam room in the new area, including the exam table, chairs, and a vital signs mobile cart.

Types of Funds

NDCF manages over 900 funds for the betterment of North Dakota citizens and their communities. Below is more information about the various types of funds we manage with examples of each. If you are interested in establishing a new fund, give our staff a call and we can help you figure out the best type of fund to accomplish your charitable-giving goals.

COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS

Community foundations are permanent, flexible, financial resources for their communities and surrounding area. The grant money they provide to local projects and programs every year can make a huge difference in the quality of life for their residents. Over time, their endowment funds can become a substantial source of funding for their communities. Some communities also establish non-endowment funds for special projects in their area. NDCF manages 69 local community foundations in North Dakota and



many have related project funds. Included in this category is:

• The Oakes Area Community Foundation, established in 1998, holds an annual golf tournament fundraiser. Local businesses, like Starion Bank, sponsor teams. On the right is John Zetocha, Market President of the Starion Bank in Oakes and Chair of the Oakes Area Community Foundation.

SCHOOL FUNDS

Numerous school foundations have been established in the last several years to provide additional resources to cash-strapped school districts. The additional funding from our school foundations fill in the gaps, providing everything from supplies to playground equipment to musical instruments to teacher housing. They can also provide long-term stability and resources for the school. In addition, several schools have established project funds at NDCF to supplement their capital projects if bids come in over estimates.

SCHOLARSHIPS

With the rising costs of higher education, more and more college-bound students need a helping hand. Donors can determine whether they want to establish a permanent or temporary scholarship fund, if it's tied to a certain high school or college major, and general guidance about selection criteria. Thank you to the generous donors who established scholarships for North Dakota students in 2023 through NDCF, including those listed here:

- Kirk Wold Memorial Trades Scholarship Fund
- Jake Wallin Memorial Law Enforcement Scholarship Fund
- AIA North Dakota Scholarship Fund

The Jake Wallin Memorial Law Enforcement Scholarship Fund was established at NDCF in 2023 by friends of the law enforcement community to honor the memory of Jake Wallin, who was killed in the line of duty in Fargo, North Dakota, on July 14, 2023 at the age of 23. Scholarships will be awarded to North Dakota and Minnesota residents to help defray expenses associated with entering the field of law enforcement.



ORGANIZATION FUNDS

Endowment funds provide long-term financial resources for organizations and can be an integral part of how they fund their operations and special projects every year. The stability of an endowment fund means the organization's mission can continue for countless generations. In addition, some organizations establish non-endowment funds at NDCF to help raise money for particular projects. Welcome to the following new organization funds:

- Pioneer Trails Regional Museum Endowment
- Gaia Home Fund
- Friends of Lake Sakakawea Endowment Fund
- ND Curling Foundation Fund



A neighborhood of residential units and community spaces, Gaia Home will be one of the first dedicated homes of its kind in the state with qualified medical care specializing in the end-of-life journey.

FISCAL SPONSORSHIPS

NDCF often serves as a fiscal sponsor for organizations, especially new causes just starting out. This allows people to focus on their passion instead of worrying about establishing 501(c)(3) status, tax implications, or other legal and administrative issues. NDCF served as the fiscal sponsor for following funds created in 2023:

- ND Native Tourism Alliance (Good Relative Collaborative Grant)
- Souris Basin Planning Council Fund
- Walhalla, ND Swimming Pool Project

The mission of the ND Native Tourism Alliance is to protect, promote, preserve, and educate the world about the culture, history and environment of our sovereign nations. NDNTA will promote and educate through sustainable tourism while developing economic opportunities for our people and nations.

SPECIAL PURPOSE (RESTRICTED) FUNDS

Some funds are established at NDCF with a specific cause in mind. These special purpose or "restricted" funds can be related to a one-time disaster response or support specific charities and projects permanently. New special purpose funds established at NDCF in 2023 include:

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDED FUNDS

When a group of donors wishes to recommend the grant awards every year from their charitable fund, they can establish a Committee-Recommended Fund at NDCF. Two new committee-recommended funds were established at NDCF in 2023. Both were established through James' trust to benefit the community of Garrison, ND.

DONOR-ADVISED FUNDS

Many families choose to establish a donor-advised fund (DAF) at NDCF and recommend where their grant dollars should go every year. A DAF provides great flexibility and amazing tax benefits. It is also known as a simpler version of a Family Foundation without the detailed legal documents or annual audit and accounting paperwork required. NDCF provides access to online statements 24/7 and donors can clarify successor fund advisors if they would like their children or grandchildren to recommend grants from the fund in the future.

"My husband Steven Nelson and I both come from generations of ranching and farming families. As part of our commitment to our community, in 2012 we set up our Donor Advised Fund Endowment with the North Dakota Community Foundation. They were a good fit because they are North Dakotans as well, and it was simple and we receive the support we want when we need it – even face-to-face as needed." - Wanda Uran-Nelson, Watford City, ND.

GIFT ANNUITIES

Charitable Gift Annuities provide an income for life to the donor and a gift to the causes that are most important to them when they're gone. CGAs are becoming an increasingly popular charitable-giving tool. NDCF manages several CGAs.

OPERATING FUNDS

Gifts to NDCF's Development Fund (non-endowment) or Operating Endowment Fund help us provide services to communities all across the state as they work to improve the quality of life for area residents. Thank you to those donors and organizations who choose to provide direct support to our organization!




The Power of Endowment

The North Dakota Community Foundation believes strongly in the power of endowment. Endowment sets aside and invests money at all times, but especially when economic winds are favorable. Endowment then provides charitable cash flow in perpetuity independent of the economic cycle. This provides a stable financial resource for the organization or community it supports.

A properly managed endowment is a resource that returns many times the original investment. Here is a chart that shows the 30+year performance of a \$100,000 endowment established at the North Dakota Community Foundation on December 31, 1989. This chart is based on the NDCF actual net investment return after paying investment advisors and taking our normal endowment management fee.

You can see that the \$100,000 initial gift had a market value of **\$169,590** at the end of 2023 and would have awarded a total of **\$192,822** in grants over the years to the charity, community, or school it was designed to support.



That's a total value of \$362,412 from the initial charitable investment.

The fund will continue to grant out charitable dollars forever.

That is the beauty and the power of an endowment fund.


