## \$7,969 Awarded in 2022

The WACF was created to be a resource to support local community initiatives which provide a higher quality of life in the Walhalla area. Last year, the WACF Advisory Committee awarded \$7,969 in three different grants to the following organizations:

- **Gorge Arts & Heritage Council:** \$1,469 for cement at the back entrance of the Walla Theatre
- Walhalla Park District: \$4,000 for graveling Riverside Park
- North Border School District Walhalla: \$2,500 for the Walhalla Playground Fundraiser

#### Other ways to give include:


- Donate stock
