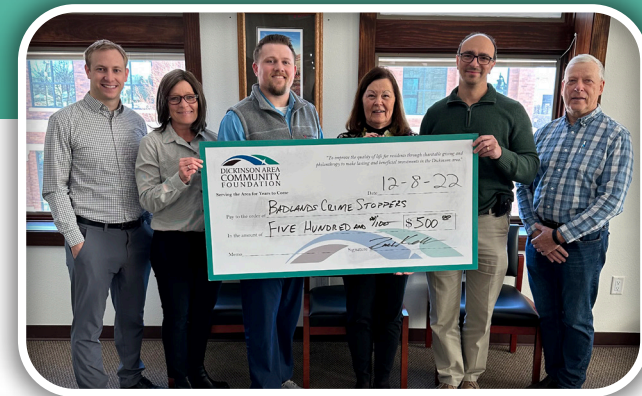
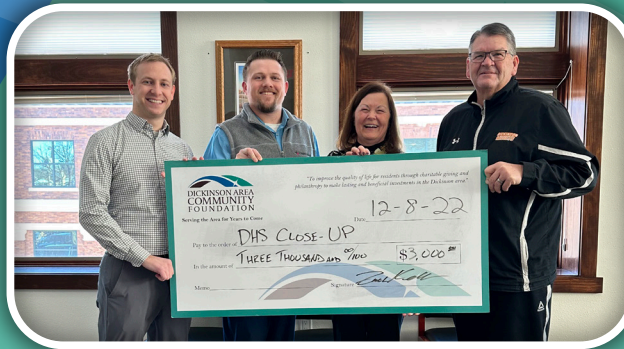

## Options for Giving

Life insurance, retirement funds, cash, stock, real estate, deferred gifts, memorials and/or bequests.

The table below shows the estimated cost of a gift to a ND qualified endowment fund for donors in the 32% tax bracket:

Gift Amount	\$5,000	\$10,000	\$25,000	\$50,000
Estimated Federal Savings	\$960	\$1,920	\$4,800	\$9,600
ND State Income Tax Credit	\$2,000	\$4,000	\$10,000	\$20,000

## Special North Dakota Tax Credit

Individuals that give at least \$5,000 and businesses that give any amount to the Dickinson Area Community Foundation may be eligible for a **40% state tax credit**, limits apply.
