The DACF awarded a total of \$5,220 in five different grants in 2023 to the following organizations:

- BIO Girls \$500 Program Costs 2024
- Big Hearts Daycare \$1,420 for outdoor storage
- Ox Cart Trails Historical Society \$1,500 for a garage for the Fireman's Hand Hose Reel
- Pembina County Meals & Transportation - \$800 - Reduced Medical Rides for Drayton Area Residents
- Drayton Sugar Bowl Citizens \$1,000 to construct ducting for the furnace



Six in ten adolescent girls battle low self-esteem. BIO Girls (Beautiful Inside & Out) is a 12-session program that is proven to build self-esteem using lifeskills lessons, positive mentoring, and noncompetitive physical activity. The girls and their mentors train for and run a 5K a the end of their program. The DACF is proud to support the Drayton BIO Girls program with grants the last three years!

What is Our Potential?

There are over 69 local community foundations in North Dakota, some that started over three decades ago and others that started last year.

The larger these permanent endowment funds grow, the more earnings are available for grants every year. Some funds award over \$40,000 in grants every year!

There are other ways to support our fund as well - which one works best for you?

- Donate stock
- Take advantage of the IRA Charitable Rollover - your donation (directly from your IRA to NDCF for our fund) counts as your Required Minimum Distribution, but you can avoid taxes on it!
- Give memorial gifts to our fund in honor of family members and friends.
- Donate agricultural commodities! Just instruct your elevator or broker to donate a certain number of bushels or head of livestock to the North Dakota Community Foundation (for the Drayton fund). If you donate the commodity BEFORE it is sold, you don't have to count the sale as income AND you can deduct the cost of production.
- Make the North Dakota Community Foundation (Tax ID#45-0336015), and specifically our fund, the beneficiary of your life insurance policy or a partial beneficiary of your estate.
- Take advantage of the tax credit.
 Individuals that give at least \$5,000 in one calendar year and businesses that donate ANY amount to the Drayton Area Community Foundation may take a 40% state income tax credit on their gift. This generous incentive can make a significant difference at tax time!
