MISSION STATEMENT The mission of the North Dakota Community Foundation is to improve the quality of life for North Dakota citizens through charitable giving and promoting philanthropy.

ABOUT THE NORTH DAKOTA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION The North Dakota Community Foundation was incorporated in 1976. NDCF is an IRS designated 501(c)(3) statewide public nonprofit tax-exempt corporation that receives and distributes charitable funds to support a wide range of programs that benefit North Dakotans.

NDCF was formed by a group of concerned citizens who were looking for a general charitable vehicle to build endowment to support the nonprofit sector in the state. Initial support for the Foundation came from the Otto Bremer Foundation (now the Otto Bremer Trust), the Northwest Area Foundation, the Northwest Bancorporation, the North Dakota Bremer Banks and the Bush Foundation.

It has continued to grow and flourish over the years thanks to the support of thousands of individuals and businesses who want to make North Dakota a better place to live, work, and play.

The office staff under the supervision of its volunteer Board of Directors carries out the work of the Foundation. Board members represent all citizens of North Dakota. All grant distribution decisions are made by the NDCF Board of Directors.

NATIONAL STANDARDS The National Standards Seal represents official confirmation from the Community Foundations National Standards Board that NDCF has met the most rigorous standards for community foundations. The seal affirms NDCF's commitment to financial security, transparency, and accountability and says that our grantmaking includes an open, competitive process designed to address the changing needs of our community.

Jo Jacobson, from Crosby (formerly from Alamo), served on the NDCF Board from 1984 to 1990.

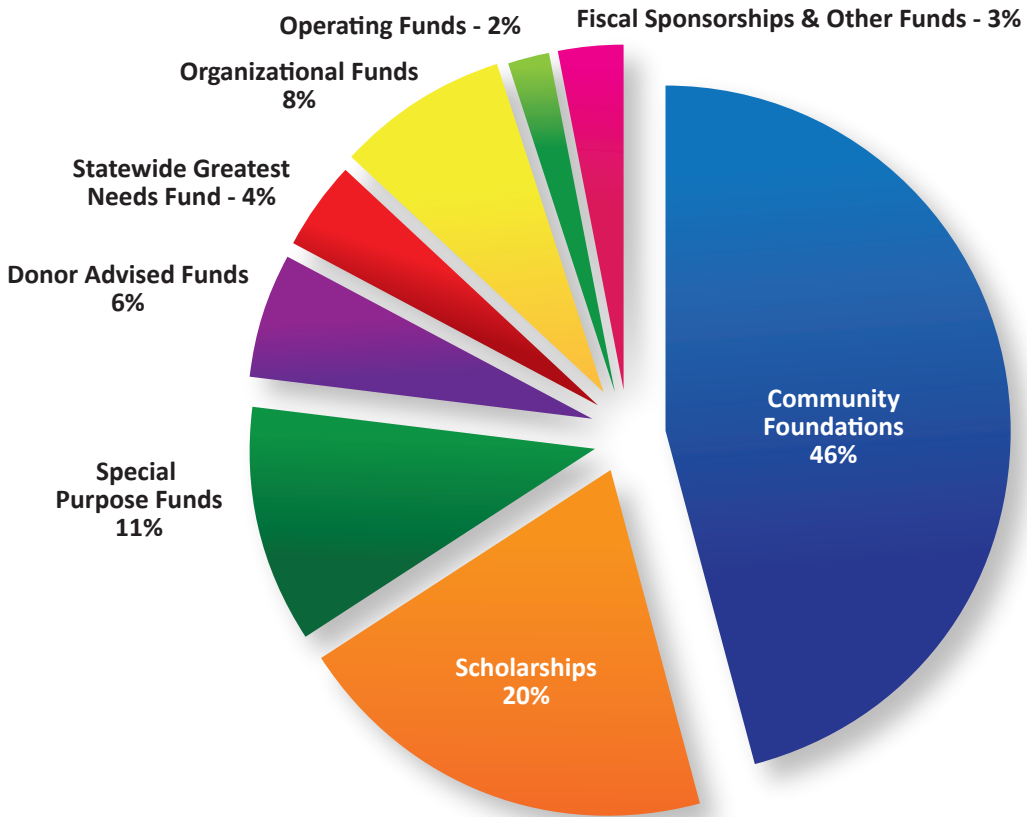
Marijo Shide, from Larimore, was an original board member serving from 1976 to 1981.

OUR COMMUNITY ENDOWMENT FUNDS

The Community Endowment Fund program is the signature program of the North Dakota Community Foundation. NDCF currently manages permanent endowment funds for 64 different communities or areas in the state. These funds each have an advisory committee made up of local residents that lead fundraising efforts and recommend grant awards. These grants fund projects and programs that greatly improve the quality of life in these communities. Here is some of the activity in our communities in 2017:



Kenmare, ND: The Kenmare Area Community Foundation hosted a Welcome Home Celebration on June 30 as a kick-off for Kenmare’s All-School Reunion weekend. Held in the high school gymnasium, current and former Kenmare residents enjoyed a social, dinner, displays of KHS memorabilia and entertainment. Former Kenmare resident and business owner Ron Rauschenberger and KHS alum and current ND State Tax Commissioner Ryan Rauschenberger were the featured speakers at the event. Community foundations keep people connected to their hometowns, even when they live elsewhere.

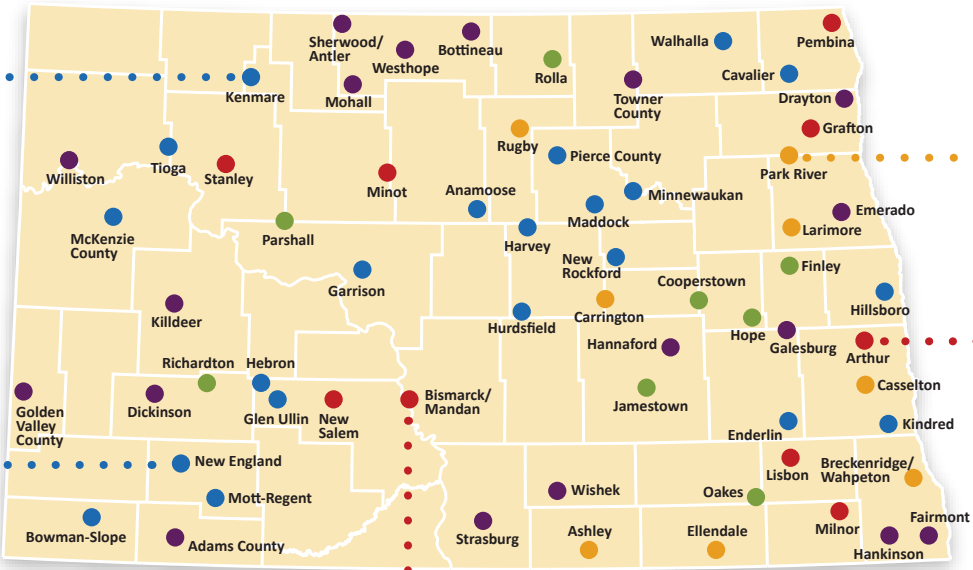

Bismarck, ND: The BisMan Community Foundation awarded \$32,160 in grants to five nonprofit organizations in the area in 2017, including \$13,660 to the Dakota Children’s Advocacy Center for the purchase of medical exam kits for sexually abused children, \$10,000 to the Great Plains Food Bank to help create a Bismarck-Mandan Regional Service Center, \$3,500 to Tracy’s Sanctuary House to update and refinish the floors in their facility, \$3,000 to Rebuilding Together Greater BisMan Area to assist low-income homeowners with home repairs, and \$2,000 to the Village Family Service Center for their Angel Fund.



Park River, ND: The Park River Area Community Endowment Fund made 7 different grants in 2017, including a grant of \$2,200 to the Kiddie Korner Preschool & Daycare to replace the central air in their daycare building. What a relief for kids on a hot summer day!

CEF Grants At Work

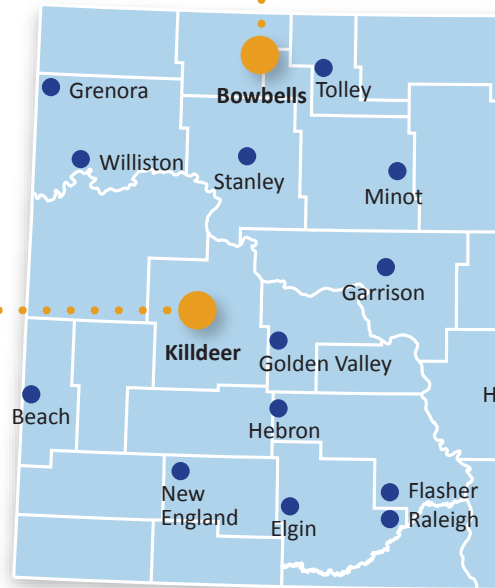
The Community of Care for Cass County, ND, has received numerous grants from the Clarence Johnson and Eunice Iwen Community Foundation for Arthur, ND, in the past to support the operating expenses of their office in Arthur. The local Arthur office provides services to enhance the quality of life for older adults in rural Cass County, including exercise classes, to help keep people in their homes as long as safely possible!

STATEWIDE GREATEST NEEDS FUND

NDCF's Statewide Greatest Needs Fund provides grant dollars for projects and programs across the state that make a significant difference in the quality of life of area residents. For some communities, NDCF's Statewide Greatest Needs Fund is the only funding source they have to help them make improvements in their town.

NDCF's Board of Directors reviewed 171 grant applications in 2017 and was pleased to award \$150,283 in grants to 36 organizations, including those shown here.

The United Methodist Church was awarded a \$2,000 grant to install a handicap sidewalk for their **Society of St. Stephens Food Pantry**. The new sidewalk replaced an old narrow one that provided the public access to the rear of the church where the Food Pantry was located. The Society of St. Stephens Food Pantry serves rural and community residents in Burke County who qualify for monthly food assistance, including people in the towns of Bowbells, Columbus, Coteau, Lignite, and Noonan.



A \$3,800 grant was awarded to the **Killdeer Area Ambulance Service** to purchase new CPR manikins and supplies to teach CPR/First Aid Training in Dunn County and portions of Billings and McKenzie Counties. Classes are offered to area daycare centers, schools, nursing homes, oil field employees, and individual citizens. Their old manikins were over 15 years old and most of them had been hand-me-downs from other agencies.

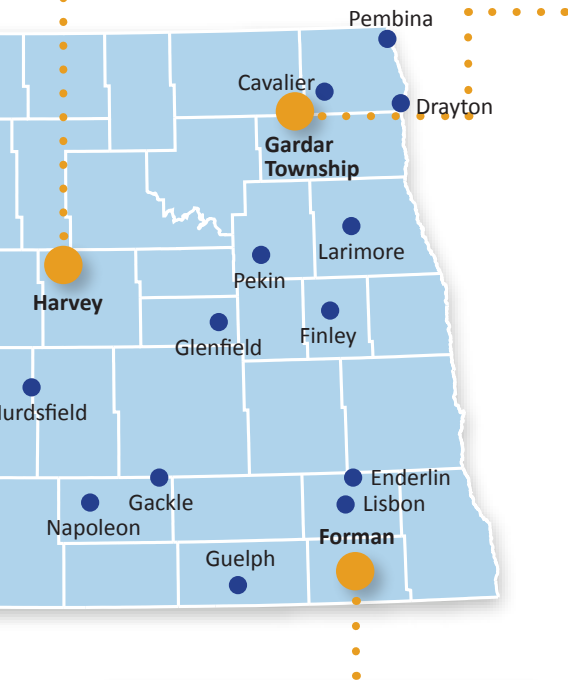

The **Harvey Police Department** was awarded a \$5,000 grant to upgrade their mobile and hand-held radios to comply with the new statewide radio system. Pictured with NDCF President and CEO Kevin Dvorak is Harvey's Chief of Police Shaine Towe.



NDCF is helping **Gardar Township** restore their township hall. Built over 100 years ago, the hall was in serious disrepair. Volunteers were assisting in making repairs including new siding, roofing, doors, and windows. The new hall will be used for athletic events, community gatherings, and other functions for the residents of this township.



The **City of Forman** received a grant for \$3,350 to purchase a tetherball set, climbing apparatus, and one more picnic table for their Central Park. Most of the older playground equipment in the park had worn out and had been removed, and only a swingset, slide, and one picnic table remained. The new equipment will help revitalize the park that is centrally located and was once a popular gathering space for local children and residents.

SWGNS GRANTS AT WORK

In 2015, NDCF awarded a Statewide Greatest Needs Grant of \$5,000 to the Dazey Fire Department for Auto Extracation Tools. Here is the photo of Kevin Dvorak, presenting the check to Dazey Fire Chief Daryl Kunze and Chris Weller of the Dazey Fire Department. The Dazey Fire Department applied for the grant after Weller himself was involved in a car crash months earlier that left him injured and trapped in his vehicle. Because they did not have the necessary equipment to free him, his friends and colleagues in the Dazey Fire Department had to wait almost an hour until a neighboring fire department could arrive with their equipment. Now the Dazey Fire Department have been training on their new equipment and are ready to respond to that situation if it ever arises again.

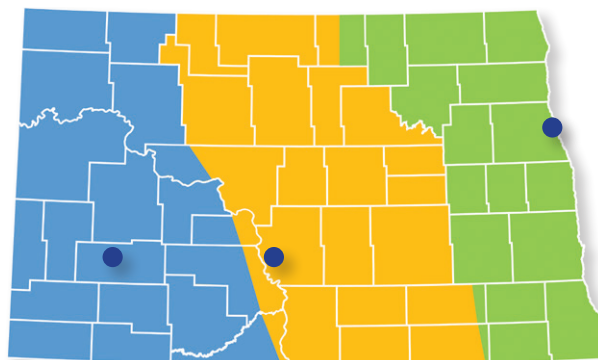

Many Ways to Support Your Favorite Fund

Most people know that they can write a check and support one of the over 650 funds at NDCF. But did you know there are many other ways that you can provide financial support to your favorite charity, community, or scholarship? Here is a brief listing of other ways to give, along with the benefits of each. For more information about these options, please contact NDCF at 701-222-8349.

LIFE INSURANCE/RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS

This is one of the easiest ways to provide financial support to a program or charity. You simply make the North Dakota Community Foundation a beneficiary (or partial beneficiary) of your policy, IRA, 401K or commercial annuity. You need to specify which fund you wish to support at NDCF.

Benefits of Life Insurance/Retirement Account beneficiary: Easy process, no tax due on tax-deferred instruments giving to charity and no impact on your current financial situation.

GIFT OF STOCK

You can also transfer stock to NDCF for a particular fund. Your investment professional simply transfers the stock directly into NDCF account. (Your investment professional can contact NDCF in Bismarck for transfer instructions).

Benefits of a Stock Transfer: Donors get to take a tax deduction for the current market value of the asset and avoid capital gains tax on the stock.

BEQUEST

A bequest is property or money that you promise in your will to give to another person or organization after you die. It enables you to maintain full control over your property and money during your lifetime and yet to receive a charitable estate tax deduction for the value of the property at the time of your death.

It is advised to have an attorney help you in drafting a will.

If you would like to leave some or all of your estate to the NDCF, the bequest language is as follows:

"I give and bequeath to the North Dakota Community Foundation (Tax ID 45-0336015), a qualified charitable organization under IRS 501(c)(3), located in Bismarck, North Dakota, _____ (a percentage of the estate, specific dollar amount, or remainder of estate) to the _____ (name of fund), a component fund of the North Dakota Community Foundation."

Benefits of Bequests: The executor of your estate will deduct the fair market value of the property you transfer to NDCF. This charitable deduction can save a substantial amount of estate tax. In addition, you will know that your gift will continue to improve the quality of life in North Dakota forever.

IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER

Individuals age 70½ or older can make gifts of up to \$100,000 directly from their IRA to the North Dakota Community Foundation, benefitting the fund of their choice. Donors can contact their IRA plan administrator directly to make the gift.

Benefits of an IRA Charitable Rollover: You can avoid taxes on transfers of up to \$100,000 and the gift will satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD) for the year. You can choose an existing fund at NDCF to support or create your own fund to support the community or charity of your choice.

THE CHARITABLE GIFT ANNUITY OPTION

Another Way for You to Support Your Community or Favorite Charity

A Charitable Gift Annuity with the North Dakota Community Foundation is a way for you to increase your income, receive a current tax deduction and ND income tax credit, and leave a charitable legacy to your community or favorite nonprofit organization for generations to come.

A person can take an asset that is not producing a large amount of income, such as a stock or CD, and gift it to NDCF as a charitable gift annuity, for the benefit of a particular endowment fund. The rates for gift annuities (see table) are particularly attractive in today's market place.

In addition to the increased income, donors are entitled to take a current income tax charitable deduction and in certain cases a North Dakota Income Tax Credit for a percentage of the gift. The Annuity can pay you, the donor (and your spouse, if you choose) a lifetime income. The remaining principle* is placed in the endowment fund of your choice at the North Dakota Community Foundation.

Just how safe is a gift annuity? The payout is backed by the North Dakota Community Foundation's over 80 million dollars in assets. NDCF has a 40-year history of careful stewardship of its endowment funds.

The North Dakota Community Foundation is not engaged in rendering legal or tax advice. This article is meant to provide general information about gift annuities and charitable giving. The Foundation recommends that any prospective donor consult their tax or legal advisor before entering into a giving program.

NORTH DAKOTA TAX CREDIT FOR CHARITABLE GIVING

There are considerable advantages to donating to a qualified North Dakota endowment fund. All of NDCF’s endowment funds are managed as ‘qualified North Dakota endowment funds’.

State Tax Credit for Endowment Gifts

Businesses (C corporations, S corporations, estates, limited liability companies, trusts, and financial institutions) that pay ND income tax may take a 40% credit up to a total of \$10,000 for gifts to the qualified endowment fund of a qualified North Dakota charity.

Individuals may receive a state tax credit for a contribution for \$5,000 or more (lump sum or aggregate in one year) to a qualified North Dakota endowment. The tax credit is 40% of the charitable deduction allowed by the IRS up to a maximum credit of \$10,000 per year per taxpayer or \$20,000 per year per couple filing jointly.

In all of the above, the credit may be carried forward for 3 additional tax years if it cannot all be used in one year.

The table below shows the actual cost of a gift to a ND qualified endowment fund for donors in the 32% tax bracket:

Gift Amount	\$5,000	\$10,000	\$25,000	\$50,000
Federal Tax Savings	(\$1,600)	(\$3,200)	(\$8,000)	(\$16,000)
ND State Income Tax Credit	(\$2,000)	(\$4,000)	(\$10,000)	(\$20,000)
Net Cost of Gift	\$1,400	\$2,700	\$7,000	\$14,000

The endowment fund at NDCF would receive the full gift amount, but the donor would have a much lower net cost of the gift. This includes gifts to any of our community endowment funds, organizational endowment funds, or donor-advised endowment funds.

Donation of Appreciated Assets

By donating assets that have increased in value over a period longer than a year, donors may generate even greater tax savings. If a donor gives appreciated assets instead of selling them, they avoid paying capital gains taxes and receive the full current market value of the asset when calculating the tax credit and federal deduction.
