Expanding the permanent fund that can support community service projects in the Parshall area for years to come.




Our Committee

Since 2012 yearly grants have been awarded to organizations in Parshall and the surrounding area totaling over \$69,000 (as of 2022).



Our Partnership

Our goal is to grow the fund to \$450,000 so we can award \$18,000 in grants yearly. Below are various ways that we can partner to achieve this goal.

- Business Challenge Gifts: Give to make a "challenge" to others in the community. Looking for 20 gifts which will strengthen our partnership & be used to engage commitment in the community.
