Each year we send this report out to share the good news of our community foundation and keep you up-to-date on its work.

Our foundation is here to help improve our community. We want to continue growing it, so that we can have a greater impact on the projects and programs that we value. As it stands now, we receive larger requests than we have the dollars for.

The fund is invested in North Dakota with North Dakota companies (like Bremer), and the annual revenue is spun off to help fund important community programs and programs. Our local committee annually reviews the grant applications and recommends grant awards - ask us if you have any questions about the process!

\$8,920 Awarded in 2022

The Harvey Area Community Foundation's Advisory Committee awarded a total of \$8,920 to the following organizations and projects in 2022:

- **Harvey Ambulance Service:** \$3,550 for a permanent generator for the Harvey Ambulance Service and the Central Dakota Food Pantry
- **Central Cinema Theater:** \$2,500 for the Central Cinema sound project
- **HWC Booster Club:** \$2,500 for a football field paint sprayer
- **Harvey Public Schools:** \$370 for an Arts Printing Unit



Grants are usually awarded once a year. Applications are available online at www.NDCF.net/Harvey and are due by September 30.

What is Our Potential?

There are over 69 local community foundations in North Dakota, some that started over three decades ago and others that started last year.

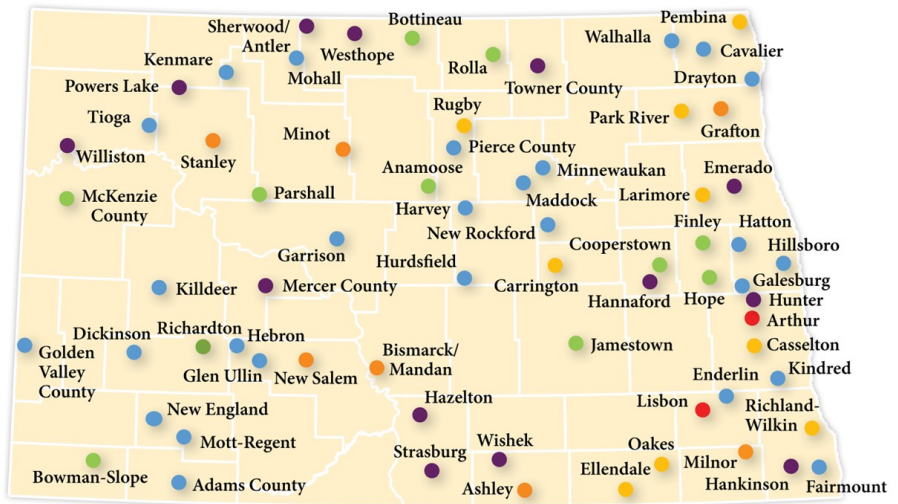
The larger these permanent endowment funds grow, the more earnings are available for grants every year. Some funds award over \$40,000 in grants every year!

Other ways to give include:

- Donate stock
- Take advantage of the IRA Charitable Rollover - your donation (directly from your IRA account to our fund) counts as your Required Minimum Distribution, but you can avoid taxes on it!
- Give memorial gifts to our fund in honor of family members and friends.
- Donate agricultural commodities! Just instruct your elevator or broker to donate a certain number of bushels or head of livestock to the North Dakota Community Foundation (for the Harvey fund). If you donate the commodity BEFORE it is sold, you don't have to count the sale as income AND you can deduct the cost of production.
