\$1,932 Awarded in 2022

The Adams County Community Foundation awarded two grants from its endowment fund earnings in September of 2022 to the following organizations:

- **Dakota Prairie Helping Hands:** \$500 for assistance with heat and light bills
- **Hettinger Public School:** \$1,432 for professional cameras for the HPS Stream Team (a program where students learn the basics of live broadcasting while livestreaming a community event for others to watch - sports, music, parades, rodeos)



Grant applications are accepted once a year and reviewed by the local Advisory Committee, which recommends grant awards.

There are over 69 local community foundations in North Dakota, some that started over three decades ago and others that started last year.

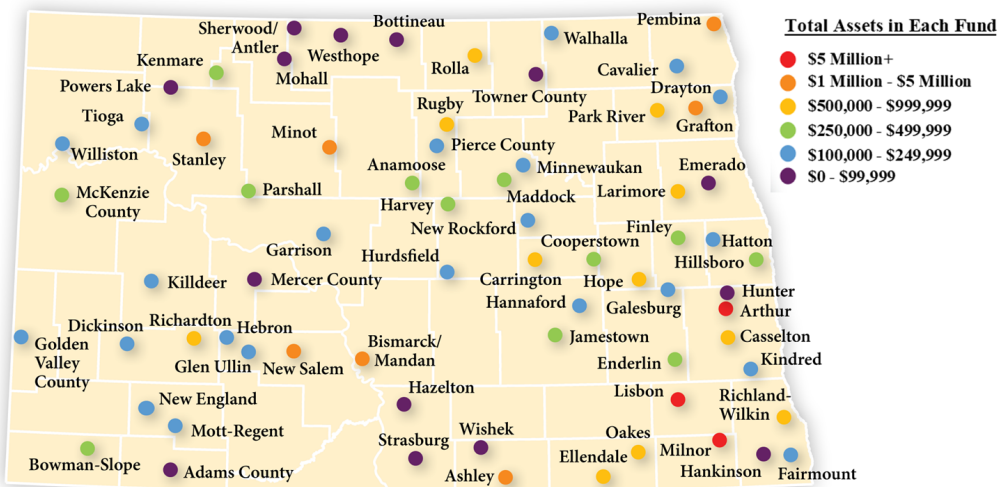
The larger these permanent endowment funds grow, the more earnings are available for grants every year. Some funds award over \$40,000 in grants every year!

Other ways to give include:

- Donate stock
- Take advantage of the IRA Charitable Rollover - your donation (directly from your IRA account to our fund) counts as your Required Minimum Distribution, but you can avoid taxes on it!
- Give memorial gifts to our fund in honor of family members and friends.
- Donate agricultural commodities! Just instruct your elevator or broker to donate a certain number of bushels or head of livestock to the North Dakota Community Foundation (for the Adams County fund). If you donate the commodity BEFORE it is sold, you don't have to count the sale as income AND you can deduct the cost of production.
